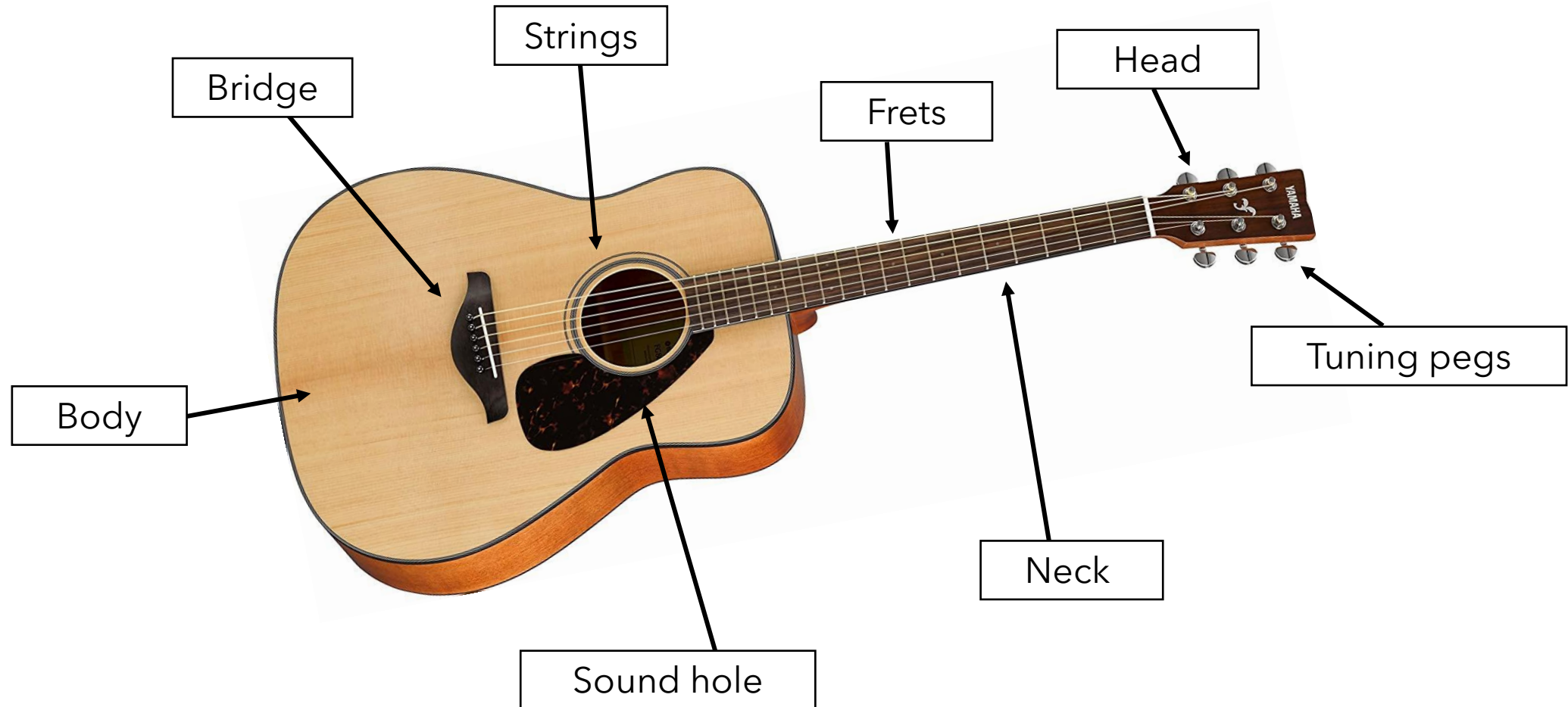

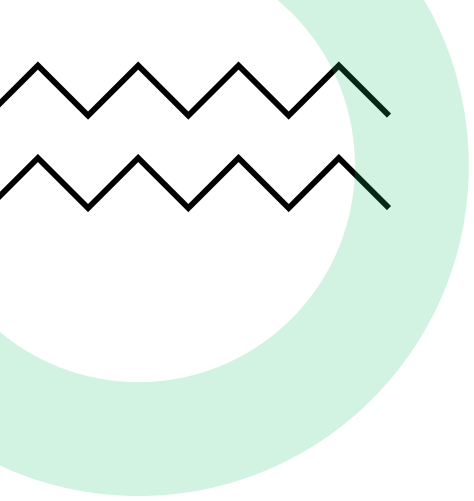

Guitar Technique

- Hold the guitar with the head of the guitar to your **left-hand** side.
- **Thumb** behind the neck of the guitar. The rest of the **fingers curve** and press down on the fingerboard.



RIGHT HAND TECHNIQUE

- Use your **thumb** to pluck the lower sounding strings.
- Use **fingers 2, 3** and **4** to pluck the higher sounding strings.
