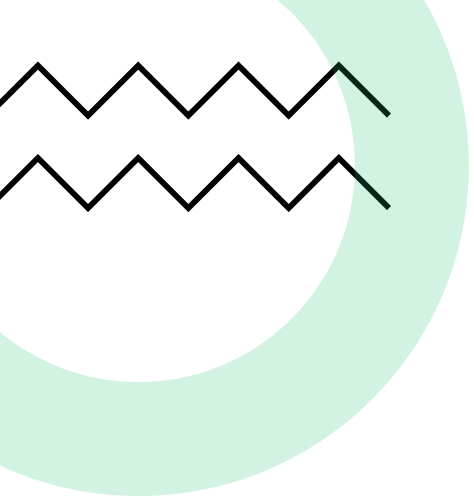

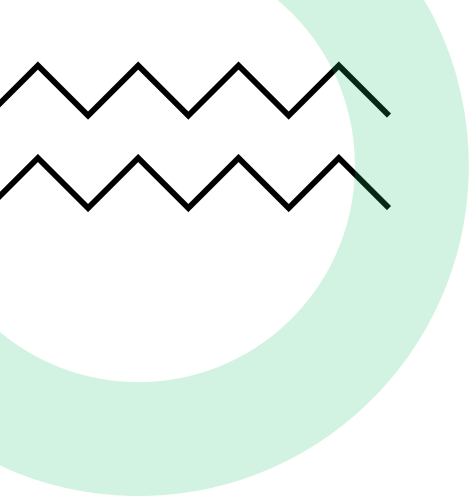


Starter:

Give examples of good **technique** when playing the guitar?

(Discuss with the person next to you)





Guitar Technique:

- Hold the guitar with the head of the guitar to your **left-hand** side.
- **Thumb** behind the neck of the guitar.
- The rest of the **fingers curve** and press down on the fingerboard.

Symbols that tell us when not to play in music. Every rest symbol has a different length/number of beats.
